ABOUT THE WINE

This Sauternes-style wine is 100% botrytised late harvest Sauvignon Blanc. The grapes are from the Croft Vineyard at the southern end of Alexander Valley, which straddles a high hillside on the border of the Russian River appellation. Cool, foggy nights followed by the warm sun during the day makes an ideal environment for the "Nobel Rot" Botrytis to grow and provide that concentration of flavors and complexity that a great Sauternes poses.

TASTING NOTES

- The nose is generous and direct with apricots, flowers, honey and pears.
- The palate is rich, lush and consistent with the bouquet.
- The finish is long and savory.

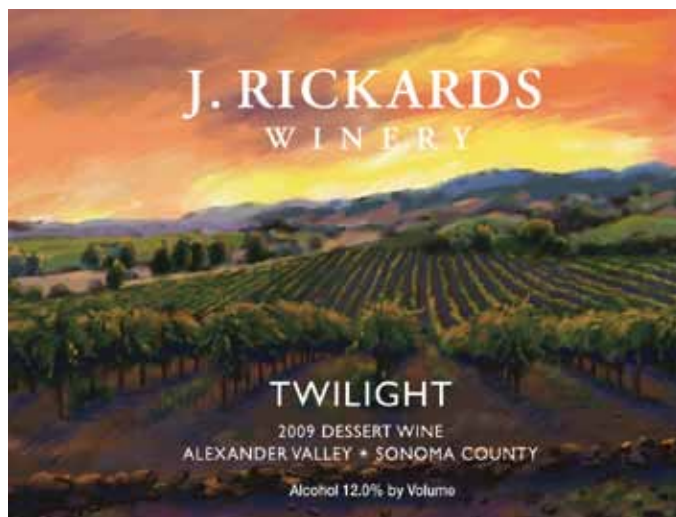
